#### Guidelines for Authors

##### 1. Eligibility

- Articles must be authored by postgraduate students (M.Sc., M.Phil., or Ph.D.) currently registered at PGIS.
- Each article should be co-authored by the student's academic supervisor/s.

##### 2. Submission Requirement

- Each student is required to submit at least one article during the course of their postgraduate program.
- The article should be based on the student's original project work.

##### 3. Target Audience

- The magazine is intended for a broad audience, including the general public and students from various disciplines. Articles should be accessible and engaging to nonspecialists.

##### 4. Content Guidelines

- Articles must focus on research findings, innovations, or scientific insights in a manner that is easy to understand without compromising academic integrity.
- Use clear, non-technical language where possible.
- Articles may include real-world applications, societal impact, and relevance of the research.

##### 5. Article Format

- **Title:** Concise and informative.
- **Author/s:** Full name/s
- **Affiliation:**
- **Body:** 800–1,200 words recommended.

- **Figures and Tables:** Up to 3 figures/tables. Must be high resolution with captions. Figures must be original.

## **6. Submission Format**

- Submit articles in Microsoft Word (.docx) format.
- Include figures/tables separately as image files (jpeg or tiff).
- Use Times New Roman, 12-point font, 1.5 line spacing.

## **7. Review Process**

- Submissions will be reviewed by two faculty members and editorial staff.
- Feedback will be provided for revisions if necessary.
- Final acceptance is contingent on quality and adherence to guidelines.

## **8. Plagiarism and Originality**

- All submissions must be original and free from plagiarism.
- Articles will be screened using plagiarism detection tools.
